Who will roll away the stone for us from the entrance to the tomb?...They said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid (Mark 16:3,8).

Easter comes early this year, arriving on the last day of March. I am looking forward to the services of Holy Week and Easter, all of which remember those events at the heart of the Christian faith. In a world filled with news that can drag us down, we need the proclamation of God's Easter victory in Christ. Knowing our inner demons that can lead us to despair, we need the comfort and assurance of God's eternal mercy and grace in Jesus Christ.

We deal with major issues in life, be they matters of personal health, life changes in work or family, or a pastoral transition in a congregation. Daily we hear stories of people suffering in warfare or contending with extreme poverty and hunger. We wonder who will roll away the stone? Who will give us hope when there appears to be no hope?

Easter proclaims God's Yes to life, God's victory over sin, death and the power of evil. We are at heart an Easter people, a community of faith centered in the joy and peace of the Good News of Jesus. Even when all the evidence around us suggests we are doomed, we carry the cross of Jesus' love and march toward the future God is unfolding.

Mark's account of the resurrection ends in a strange way. Mark says the women fled from the tomb with terror and amazement seizing them. Why did Mark end the story this way? Some say he was interrupted and didn't get to finish writing it. Some say there was more to the story but it's been lost. Another possibility is that Mark wants us to finish the story and live into God's Promised Future. Perhaps Mark is saying we Christians here on earth are now part of the Easter story. Led by the Spirit of the Risen Christ we continue the ministry of Jesus as the Body of Christ in the world today.
