In 2 Corinthians 9, Paul describes God's abundant blessings as something we must sow in order to reap. God supplies us with seeds of faith that we plant through obedience to him. When we harvest God's blessings we are transformed into more spiritually complete followers of Christ.

At First United Lutheran, we are in the process of harvesting God's blessings. God's blessings have provided us with many pastoral voices. We are so grateful for their services.

As we move forward in the pastoral leadership transition, we welcome Pastor Heidi Borkenhagen as our associate interim. The synod continues working to secure a senior interim pastor who will guide the council and congregation with the leadership and process to do the required work. The first step in the process involves gathering basic ministry information.

- Most recent Vision, Mission and Values
- Current active ministries
- Current lay leadership positions
- Current staffing
- Current congregation statistics
- Current financial picture

The interim pastor and the council discuss what we have been learning about us and identify the leadership and process to do the work. Once the basic ministry structure is clarified and stable, the interim pastor will establish the Ministry Exploration Team (MET). There are four basic questions that the interim pastor will facilitate.

- Who are we?
- Who is our neighbor?
- What is God up to internally and externally and how are we called to participate?
- How do we articulate the kind of pastoral leadership do we need?

Once the MET collects the above data they will develop a Ministry Site Profile (MSP) which will be presented to the congregation. This is followed by the establishment of the Call Committee. This is where God asks for our patience and understanding and prayers as we search for the right pastors for FULC.

We pray: God, you yearn for us to be well. When seasons change and doubts assail, you carry our burdens and hear our prayers. Assure us of your steadfast love, as near to us as the autumn air we breathe.
