A note from Pastor Jon Breimeier:

Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and undergo great suffering....and be killed, and on the third day be raised.

Then Jesus told his disciples, "If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me." Matthew 16:21, 24

The gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke each have this core passage

Peter and the disciples beginning to grasp fully who Jesus is, namely the Messiah, the Anointed One Jesus telling them in no uncertain terms that being the Messiah will mean suffering – death - resurrection Jesus telling them in no uncertain terms what to expect as his disciples

Matthew 16 is the gospel for the first weekend in September; the remaining gospels for the monthteach us more about being disciples, especially about forgiveness and truth, and about God's generosity to God's people. God's steadfast love never fails us, the Psalms tell us over and over. God's nature is not like our human nature; Jesus tells us two trenchant parables this September to help get that across, so that our treatment of others can steadily become more in keeping with God's treatment of us.

I just wanted to let everyone know how Confirmation ministries will be working this fall. We look forward to our time with your teenagers, helping them to understand and articulate what it is to be a Christian, a Lutheran, and to be a part of this congregation.

I have emailed all of the 7th, 8th, and 9th grade families about our upcoming schedule. If you have not received the schedule, I ask that you reach out to the church office so we can add you to our list or verify your information.

We will have two Confirmation Orientations on September 20th in the Genszler Room.

- The first will be for 7th & 8th Grades at 6:00 pm until 6:45pm for Students and Parents
- The second will be for 9th Grade at 7:00 pm until 8:00pm for Students, Parents and Mentors

Confirmation Classes for 7th and 8th Grade will begin the first Wednesday of October on October 4 and meet weekly.

Confirmation Classes for 9th Grade will meet the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of October, starting on October 4.

We have had a great response to our need for mentors, though I am still looking for 3 additional male mentors.

Our 7th and 8th graders will be working their way through the small catechism and working through the books of the Bible this year and the 9th graders will be working to build relationships with their mentors and discussing questions of faith.

newsletter. (summer, 2023) Loosely quoting here: The church is called to be political, to be active in public for the good of our neighbors and God's creation; the church is called to avoid partisan politics. Find the whole article at the synod web site.

Father James Martin. Search him for Ignatian practices of daily devotion and reflection, especially the practice of imagining yourself within Bible stories. Search him for humor and laughter in the church, e.g. Between Heaven and Mirth. Find his book Jesus: A Pilgrimage – He chronicles a trip to the holy land,

combining biblical background, his observations of the actual place where Bible narratives happened, his imagining himself in the gospel stories, and how his understanding and faith grew through the experience.




